DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

Rescinding Rama Bylaw No. 5: Establishing a Community Recreation Committee and Community Recreation Program

WHEREAS on November 24, 1966, the then Chief and Council of the Chippewas of Rama First Nation passed a Band Council Resolution No. 475-1966-67-30 enacting Rama Bylaw No. 5 "Establishing a Recreation Committee and Community Recreation Program";

AND WHEREAS the Recreation Committee has long since been disbanded and the social, cultural and physical recreation programs offered by Rama First Nation are now managed and maintained by the Chippewas of Rama First Nation Administration;

AND WHEREAS Chief and Council of Rama First Nation have directed that they wish to rescind Rama Bylaw No. 5 as being redundant;

AND WHEREAS on July 25, 2011 a quorum of Chief and Council adopted Band Council Resolution No. 476-2011-2012-012 rescinding Bylaw No. 5, however, such Band Council Resolution was not received by the Minister's office in time to satisfy the statutory requirements set out in the *Indian Act* and was deemed by the Minister to have not been properly enacted, and therefore a new Band Council Resolution is required to rescind Bylaw No. 5;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by a quorum of Chief and Council at a duly convened meeting to rescind and replace Band Council Resolution No. 476-2011-2012-012 with this Band Council Resolution which hereby rescinds Rama Bylaw No. 5 "Establishing a Recreation Committee and Community Recreation Program" originally enacted on November 24, 1966.

BY-LAW # 5

That this is a By-Law to authorize the carrying on of a community program of recreation within the meaning of the regulations under the Department of Education Act.

We further resolve:

That pursuant to Regulations 19/66 made under the Department 1. (a) of Education Act, a community program of recreation is hereby established for the residents of the Reserve

The said Community Program of Recreation shall be directed, (b) managed and controlled on behalf of the Council by a committee known as the Chippewas of Rama Recreation Committee.

2. The Chippewas of Rama Recreation Committee shall be composed of at least five members and not more than twelve, of whom at least two are member os the Council that appoints it.

3. The term of office of the Recreation Committee members shall be determined by the Council.

The Committee shall conduct or encourage and assist the 4. programmes of recreation which will meet the needs and interests of the inhabitants of the Rama Reserve. Such programmes shall include the social, cultural and physical aspects of recreation as applied to each group, both male and female.
