BAND COUNCIL RESOLUTION

THE COUNCIL OF THE: CHIPPEWAS OF RAMA

BY-LAW 7

That we form a By-Law creating a local development commission to be known as the Chippewas of Rama Development Commission of Rama Reserve # 32.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Chippewas of Rama Band.

1. That the Local Development Commission be known as the Chippewas of Rama Development Commission be and the same is hereby created.
2. The Commission shall consist of seven (7) persons, resident and registered members of the Chippewas of Rama and shall be appointed by the Council of the Chippewas of Rama.
3. Not less than two (2) member so the said Commission shall be members of the Council, two (2) of whom shall be appointed every two (2) years, and the remaining five (5) members shall be appointed for the following terms:
 - One member for a period of 5 years,
 - One member for a period of 4 years,
 - One member for a period of 3 years,
 - One member for a period of 2 years,
 - One member for a period of 1 year.
 thereafter, all appointments, except the members of the Council who shall be appointed for a period of two (2) years, shall be for a term of five (5) years each, and the members shall serve until successors are appointed and qualified.
4. The Commission shall organize immediately upon it's appointment and shall designate a time for its organization meeting in each year. The Commission shall have monthly meetings and such other meetings as may be determined by said Commission. The Chairman and Treasurer of the Commission shall be elected at its organization meeting each year and the Band Administrator shall serve as Secretary to the Commission. Such other officers and employees shall be elected or appointed as the Commission shall deem necessary. The treasurer shall receive all monies payable to the Commission and deposit them in an account in the name of the Commission and shall make monthly reports, to the Commission and Council, of receipts and disbursements showing the balance on hand. All disbursements be made only by presentation of proper vouchers therefor and upon the cheques authorized by the Commission, signed by the Chairman and Treasurer.
5. The Commission shall be vested with the powers and duties defined and designated in Paragraph 6 of this By-Law, but where the exercise of such powers and duties shall involve an expenditure exceeding the sum of \$2,000.00 (Two Thousand) the approval of the Council shall be required. All leases or transfer of property will also be subject to the approval of Council.
6. The power and duties vested in the said Commission be and the same hereby defined and designated as follows:
 - (a) Provide for the planning development of construction, erection, improvement, alteration, extension, maintenance operation, use, management, regulation, control and supervision of Marina Development, Black River Park Development and any other development that is economic in nature, on properties owned by the Council, known as Band Lands.

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6. (b) Adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for the use of Marina, Park and any other development that is economic in nature, on properties owned by the Council, known as Band Lands.
- (c) Regulate the service and fix rates for the use of the Marina and Park for the use of all facilities upon said lands owned by the Council, known as Band Lands.
- (d) Enter into lease or leases with individuals, partnerships, or corporations for the operation of concessions for the sale of fuel and oil and furnishing of water or other utilities to boats using said Marina, and Trailers and Campers using Park. All said concessions shall be approved by Council.
- (e) With full power to do all other acts which may be determined or deemed advisable by said Commission as necessary for the development economically of said Community.
7. This By-Law shall take effect immediately.
