BY-LAW # 79-11

 Addendum to By-Law # 4, dated June 3, 1968 to be known as
 BY-LAW NUMBER 79 - 11.

That the Original By-Law Number 4 become Section 1, paragraphs
 (a) to (e), and paragraph (f) is now deleted.

Further:

Section 2 - Collection of Garbage and Waste:

- (a) Band Council will institute a garbage collection service on a weekly or bi-weekly basis.
- (b) Cost of program will be covered by a fee to each household for collection of garbage.
- (c) Fee for such service will be determined by Council and amended from time to time.
- (d) All garbage for pick-up shall be contained in properly designed garbage bags or garbage containers.
- (e) No automobile or auto parts or other heavy scrap metal may be set out for pick-up.

Section 3 - Disposal Site and Penalty:

- (a) No person or persons shall deposit any garbage or waste material at the site except in designated areas clearly marked by signs.
- (b) No vehicles, cars, or trucks shall be deposited at the site.
- (c) No person or persons, who is not a Rama rate-payer under this program may use these disposal facilities. Any person who violates any provisions of this By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$300.00. Further contravention of Section 3 (c) will result in charges under Section 30 and Section 81 of the Indian Act.

 NOW KNOWN AS
 BY-LAW # 79-11

That we request Indian Affairs Branch to approve the following By-Law and request enforcement be implemented at once.

The Council of the Chippewas of Rama Band of Indians at a meeting held June 3, 1968 make the following by-Law pursuant to paragraph (a) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act, By-Law No. 4.

A By-Law to provide for the disposal of garbage and waste on the Rama Reserve in the Province of Ontario, Canada.

SECTION 1 -

- (a) No person shall accumulate or permit to be accumulated upon lands in his possession or deposit or accumulate on the lands in possession of another person anything which is or may become offensive or injurious to health.
- (b) No person shall deposit any dead animal, offal, fish, manure, garbage, fruit, vegetables, filth, liquid, waste or anything of a nature which is or may become offensive or prejudicial to health upon or into any highway, street, road, alley, lane, lot, ditch, wharf, dock, lake, pond, river, stream, well or sewer or into any land or premises with the reserve. Any such deposit shall be deemed a nuisance, provided, however that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to the deposit and proper disposal of any such material into or at a place within the reserve approved by the Council for that purpose.
- (c) The Council may arrange for the regular removal of garbage and waste from any premises within the reserve.
- (d) In the spring of each year as soon as weather conditions permit, the person in possession of any premises with the reserve shall collect all waste matter lying thereon including cans, bottles, paper and animal manure.
- (e) All such waste matter shall be disposed of in such a manner as will prevent any nuisance or offence as the fouling of wells and water supply.

SECTION 2 -

Collection of Garbage and Waste

- (a) Band Council will institute a garbage collection service on a weekly or bi-weekly basis.
- (b) Cost of program will be covered by a fee to each household for collection of garbage.
- (c) Fee for such service will be determined by Council and amended from time to time.
- (d) All garbage for pick-up shall be contained in properly designed garbage bags or garbage containers.
- (e) No automobile or auto parts or other heavy scrap metal may be set out for pick-up.
