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Independent Practitioner's Review Engagement Report

To the Members of Chippewas of Rama First Nation

We have reviewed the accompanying Schedule of Remuneration and Expenses - Chief and Councillors of Chippewas of Rama First Nation for the year ended March 31, 2020, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (together "the Schedule"). The Schedule has been prepared by management, pursuant to the requirements of the Department of Indigenous Services Canada and Health Canada 2019 - 2020 Year-end Reporting Handbook.

1. Definition of Remuneration and Expenses
