RAMA FIRST NATION
Chief Island Permit Area Regulation

Regulation No 21-02 to the Chief Island Bylaw

This Regulation shall come into force and effect on August 30, 2021.

Preamble

WHEREAS the Chippewas of Rama First Nation enacted the Chief Island Protection By-law on July 21, 2021;

AND WHEREAS the Chief Island Protection By-law, under subsection 5.1.2 (e), empowers the Chief and Council of the Chippewas of Rama First Nation to make regulations regarding terms and conditions which may be attached to a permit as may be necessary for the protection of Chief Island;

NOW THEREFORE, the Chippewas of Rama First Nation enacts as follows:

1. Short Title

This Regulation may be called the Permit Area Regulation.

2. Application

This Regulation applies to all visitors wishing to access Chief Island, as defined in section 3.1 (c) of the Chief Island Bylaw.

3. Permit Area

Permits are required within 100 meters from the shoreline.


THIS REGULATION IS HEREBY made at a duly convened meeting of the Chief and Council of the Chippewas of Rama First Nation this day of August 30, 2021.
