Be Positive. Never Criticize.

Remember that these are children playing for the fun of the game.

Remember that coaches/managers/trainers are volunteers.

In competition, someone always loses. If you do win, do it gracefully, not boastfully. If you lose, do not allow children to become negative. Applaud good plays by your team, as well as members of the opposing team.

Officials decisions must be considered final. Please remember that some of these officials are new to refereeing and need encouragement to continue developing their skills. Arguing with officials is not helpful, set a good example for the children.

Parents who anger or degrade a player, coach or referee are subject to disciplinary action by the Little NHL Committee and/or Rama First Nation.

Parents are responsible for arranging safe transportation to and from practices and games.

Alert coaches of any player health concerns or absences (practice or games).

**Your child's team Management will need all the support and help you can offer. Please make yourself available and volunteer some time if you can. Remember that coaches are volunteers!**
